Agriculture Education Foundation Scholarship Application

2023 Details: In the fall semester of 2023, four renewal scholarships and two new scholarships will be offered—(1) for any institution (1) for a student attending Central State University. In addition, \$2,000 of additional funding will be awarded to Central State University Students attending the Bahamas Agriculture and Marine Science Institute (BAMSI). All students must be enrolled and successfully completing an agriculture educator program for agriculture instruction or extension.

Applicants must have application materials submitted no later than August 15, 2023, 5pm. Awards will be made no later than August 30, 2023. Funds for the fall semester 2023 will be made available through the institution and may be rolled over to the next semester as applicable.

The scholarship will not be awarded if applications are not completed in entirety and submitted by August 15, 2023 5pm.
